

CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

THE GRID X LAMBORGHINI

Title 1: Specific Conditions

1. Organising Company

The company THE GRID, a French société par actions simplifiée (SAS) with share capital of 1,000 euros, whose registered office is located at 20 bis rue Louis Philippe 92200 NEUILLY-SUR-SEINE (hereinafter the « Organising Company »), is organising a championship « THE REAL RACE SUPER TROFEO ESPORTS by THE GRID at E-MOTION », from 21 June 2026 to 4 October 2026 inclusive (hereinafter the « Championship »).

2. Participants

The Championship is open to any natural person who will be over 14 years of age on 21 June 2026 (hereinafter the « Participant »). If the winner is a minor on the date of the event, their participation will be subject to the presence and accompaniment of an adult holding parental authority or possessing written parental authorisation.

Excluded from any participation in the Championship and from the benefit of any prize, whether directly or indirectly, are all persons who will have collaborated in the organisation of the Championship.

3. Terms of participation

Duration: from 21 June to 4 October 2026.

Registrations for the Championship remain open until the last qualifying round, i.e. no later than 4 October 2026.

Participation in the Championship requires the Participant to register online on the website www.the-grid.racing and to attend in person at the participating E-MOTION network centres on the scheduled day and time, in order to complete their participation through the associated driving session.

The Participant must complete the entire race offered in order to be included in the ranking designated in article 4 of these regulations.

4. Championship format

The Championship is accessible to any person meeting the conditions defined in article 2 of the Specific Conditions, and who submits to the format described in this article.

The Championship will be composed of four (4) rounds.

The provisional calendar of the Championship is established as follows, it being specified that it remains subject to minor changes at the initiative of the Organising Company:

- ROUND 1: from 21 June 2026 to 19 July 2026;
- ROUND 2: from 24 July 2026 to 9 August 2026;
- ROUND 3: from 28 August 2026 to 13 September 2026;
- ROUND 4: from 18 September 2026 to 4 October 2026.

The Participant registers divided as follows:

- Warm Up: 10 min
- Race of 10 laps

Once the race has started, it cannot be restarted from the beginning. The Participant may take part as many times as they wish; only the best race time will be taken into account in the final ranking.

A ranking is established for each round, classifying all participants based on their total race time.

At the end of each round, drivers ranked from 1st to 11th place will be awarded points based on their timed performance. At the end of the last round, the general ranking will determine the championship result, by adding up the points obtained during each round. In the event of a tie on total race time, the drivers concerned will be separated on the basis of the best lap time of the session affected by the tie.

The summary table for the allocation of points according to the ranking is shown below.

For each round, the car and settings are defined in advance by the Organising Company and will be identical for each of the Participants. As regards the vehicle used, all the rounds of the Championship will be contested on the simulator reproducing the following vehicle:

- Lamborghini Huracán racing version equivalent to the Lamborghini Huracán ST EVO 2.

The Organising Company reserves the right to modify the vehicle used in case of technical, operational or sporting necessity.

5. Terms of participation

5.1. Registration terms

The Participant may register for the Championship on the website www.the-grid.racing/fr, by:

- Paying a registration fee per round of €55 incl. VAT;
- Subscribing to a session set at an amount of €30 incl. VAT (and €30 incl. VAT for any retry).

5.2. Conditions of validity of participation

The Participant must use a simulator certified « GT Ultimate » by THE GRID.

The Participant accepts without reservation the equipment made available to the participants by the organiser, namely: a GT Ultimate LP Simu simulator, equipped with MOZA RACING components. The organiser certifies the hardware configuration as well as the settings.

To this end, all parameters of « GT Ultimate » simulators and of the Championship will be configured identically for each round for all Participants in order to guarantee fairness.

Any unauthorised modification of the technical parameters of the vehicle or of the simulator applicable to a driving session will be considered as non-compliance and will result in the automatic cancellation of the timed performance of the driver concerned. This irregularity may be observed either in real time during the session, or subsequently, in particular through the analysis of telemetry data and any other technical element available.

This cancellation will occur without any possibility of reimbursement of the session concerned, nor any compensation whatsoever.

5.3.

The Participant is informed and accepts that the information entered in the registration form constitutes proof of their identity pending the presentation of the relevant supporting documents.

6. Designation of winners

The Participant achieving the best race time of each round will be the winner, i.e. 4 winners for 4 rounds (hereinafter « Round Winners »).

Furthermore, at the end of each round, a general ranking will be established by adding up the points obtained by each driver. There will be three (3) winners of the general ranking (hereinafter « General Ranking Winners »).

In addition, a non-winning participant will also be drawn at random at the end of the challenge, i.e. on 5 October 2026, from among all participants in the challenge (hereinafter « Prize Draw Winner »).

The validated and final results will be accessible on the website www.the-grid.racing

7. Presentation of the prizes

7.1. Round Winners

At the end of each round, the Participant having achieved the best race time receives two tickets for the final of the Lamborghini Super Trofeo championship, to be held in Monza from 21 to 23 October 2026. Transport and accommodation expenses related to participation in the event shall be borne solely by the participant

This ticket will grant:

- Access to the Lamborghini Hospitality;
- The opportunity to participate in a hot lap (circuit lap) as a passenger with a professional driver*;
- The opportunity to take part in a Lamborghini test drive within the event area*.

* The winner must hold a valid driving licence and comply with all participation, safety, and eligibility requirements established by the event organizer. Activities are subject to the availability of the track, vehicles, drivers, and weather conditions.

7.2. General Ranking Winners

At the end of the four (4) rounds:

- The 1st place winner having obtained the most points wins a « MOZA x Lamborghini Essenza SCV12 Steering Wheel » produced by Moza Racing;
- The 2nd place winner wins a « KS Steering Wheel » produced by Moza Racing;
- The 3rd place winner wins an « HBP Handbrake » and an « HGP Sequential Shifter » produced by Moza Racing.

7.3. Prize Draw Winner

At the end of the four (4) rounds, the Prize Draw Winner will receive simulator accessories from Moza Racing. The bundle in question comprises:

- R5 DD Base;
- ES Steering Wheel;
- SR-P Lite Pedals;
- Desk Clamp.

Title 2 - General Conditions

1. Participation

- Participation in the Championship implies full and complete acceptance of these regulations (titles 1 and 2) and of any addenda thereto, without reservation.
- Participation in the Championship is strictly nominative. Only one participation and/or registration per household (same surname, first name and address) will be accepted, a Participant being unable in any case to play under several names or on behalf of another person. Participants authorise any verification concerning their identity and other information requested in strict compliance with article 9 of the Civil Code.
- Any registration by any means other than that specified in the Specific Conditions will not be taken into account. Any participation that is in particular incomplete, illegible with inaccurate details or sent after the registration deadline set in the Specific Conditions, will be considered void.
- Any false indication (identity, address, etc.) and/or any attempt at fraud will result in the immediate nullity of the participation, without prejudice to the rights of the Organising Company to prosecute the perpetrator of the offence. The Organising Company may exclude any Participant who, by their deceitful or fraudulent behaviour, harms the proper running of the Championship.
- Any Participant contravening the provisions of these regulations by any means whatsoever will not be able to claim the prize that could have been awarded to them, said prize remaining the property of the Organising Company.

2. Delivery of the Prizes

2.1. Each winner will be informed of their prize by the Organising Company by any means of their choice (email, telephone call or postal mail) at the contact details they will have indicated during their registration for the Championship. Non-winning Participants will not be informed.

2.2. The prizes awarded may not give rise to any dispute of any kind by the winner, nor to the delivery of their cash equivalent (in whole or in part), nor to their exchange for any reason whatsoever. However, the Organising Company reserves the right to substitute, at any time, any one of the prizes proposed with a prize of equivalent value, without its liability being engaged thereby.

2.3. If the winner does not want or cannot take possession of their prize or use it during the period of validity, they will not be entitled to any compensation, and the Organising Company then reserves the right to allocate the prize to a substitute winner.

Prizes not awarded due to insufficient Participants and/or winners will remain the property of the Organising Company, which may, if it so wishes, offer them again in a subsequent competition.

2.4. The prizes are awarded on a nominative basis and may not under any circumstances be retrieved or used by any other person designated by the Participants who won them.

3. Use of equipment / connection

With regard to the terms of participation described in the Specific Conditions, the Organising Company declines all liability in the event of misuse, of an incident linked to misuse of the equipment or software by the Participant, of an act of vandalism, of disruptions, of breakdown, of hacking or of any technical event that would result in a malfunction of the server, of the Internet access, of the internet or telephone connection or of the computer that could, over a given period, prevent access to the Championship.

In case of technical malfunction of a simulator preventing a Participant from completing a race or a timed session (hotlap), the Organising Company may, at its discretion, arrange a new session or restart the round concerned in order to allow the Participant to compete under fair conditions.

In any event, participation in the Championship implies in particular knowledge and acceptance by the Participant of the characteristics and limits of the Internet and in particular the absence of protection of certain data against possible misappropriation or hacking, or the risks of contamination by any viruses present on the network, as well as acceptance of the regulations of the sim center concerned.

4. Personal Data

4.1. Processing carried out. The Participant's personal data is processed by the Organising Company on the basis of their consent and of the management of their contractual relationship with the Organising Company. The processing of this personal data is carried out in particular in compliance with law no. 78-17 of 6 January 1978 in force and with European Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter « Personal Data Legislation »).

When participating in the Championship, the Participant will be invited to complete or fill in a form in which certain data, indicated by an express mention, will be mandatory. The other data is optional. In the absence of a response from the Participant or if the personal information provided is incorrect, the Organising Company will not be able to take their participation in the Championship into account. Furthermore, after determination of the winners, the Organising Company may collect directly from the latter certain additional information for the purposes of the proper delivery of the prize or prizes to be won.

The processing of the Participants' personal data has in particular as its purpose the awareness-raising of the staff of the Organising Company on the topics of diversity, the organisation, management and improvement of the Championship and of the promotional operations linked thereto, the taking into account of your participation, the determination of the winner or winners and the awarding or delivery of the prize or prizes.

The Organising Company processes, collects and retains only the personal data voluntarily transmitted by the Participant. In this respect, the Participant guarantees the veracity and accuracy of the information provided by themselves.

4.2. Recipients of the Data.

Access to the personal data of the Participants is granted only to the persons and services that are authorised to know it within the framework of the execution and management of the processing purposes mentioned above (e.g.: marketing and/or communication services of the group to which the Organising Company belongs, technical hosting and maintenance providers, etc.) and/or insofar as such access is required by a legal or regulatory basis.

The Organising Company ensures that these recipients implement appropriate security and confidentiality measures so that the personal data is protected.

4.3. The rights of the Participant

The Participant has the right to access, rectify, restrict processing, erase and request the portability of their personal data by writing to the email address specified in article 8 of the Specific Conditions. Using the same email address, the Participant may also object for legitimate reasons to the Processing of their personal data, including its processing for marketing purposes. They also have the right to formulate specific or general directives concerning the conservation, erasure and communication of their data post-mortem.

The Participant also has the possibility of lodging a complaint at the following address: dpo@e-motion.racing, or with the French Personal Data Protection Authority, the Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés (CNIL), if they consider that their rights are not respected. For more information, the User is invited to consult the CNIL website at the following address: www.cnil.fr.

4.4. Data retention period

The Organising Company undertakes to retain the Participant's personal data for the duration of the Championship and of the awarding of the prize or prizes, which may not exceed 3 months, extended, where applicable, by the applicable legal or regulatory limitation periods to which the Organising Company may be subject.

4.5. Data Security

The Organising Company undertakes to maintain adequate technical and organisational security measures in order to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the Participants' personal data to protect them from any destruction, loss, alteration or unauthorised disclosure.

5. Disputes and liability

5.1. The execution of the Championship and the interpretation of these regulations are subject to French law. Any dispute that cannot be resolved amicably will be submitted to the competent French jurisdiction.

5.2. Any claim or complaint by a Participant, for any reason whatsoever, must be transmitted to the Organising Company within a maximum period of one (1) month after the closure of the Championship by registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt to the Address of the Organising Company mentioned in article 8 of the Specific Conditions. No other method of claim or complaint will be accepted. This letter must indicate the precise date of participation in the Championship, the full contact details of the Participant and the exact reason for the claim.

5.3. The Organising Company reserves the right to shorten, extend, postpone, modify or cancel the Championship or the date of designation of the winners if circumstances so require, and in particular in case of force majeure, without any indemnity being claimable by the Participants or the liability of the Organising Company being engaged thereby.

5.4. Without its liability being engaged, the Organising Company may cancel or suspend all or part of the Championship if it appears that frauds or irregularities have occurred in any form whatsoever during its running, without prejudice to the proceedings it reserves the right to take against the persons concerned.

5.5. The Participant acknowledges and accepts that the information resulting from the computer systems of the Organising Company has probative force in any dispute relating to the Championship and to the connection elements or to the computerised processing of said information.

5.6. The Organising Company cannot be held responsible for the consequences of any delays or losses of postal or electronic mail that are not attributable to it.

5.7. The Organising Company declines all liability in case of incident and/or accident and/or damage or prejudice, direct or indirect, that could occur during the period of enjoyment of the prize and/or because of its use. The Organising Company cannot be held responsible for the use or trading of the prizes by the winners.

6. Receipt of notifications and informational newsletters

The Participant may, at any time and free of charge, request the Organising Company to no longer receive advertising or commercial solicitations by contacting the Organising Company directly at the address indicated in article 8 of the Specific Conditions or via the unsubscribe link included in any solicitation sent by electronic mail. This opposition is without prejudice to the legality of the messages sent before the objection was made. In accordance with article L.223-2 of the Consumer Code, the Participant is informed of their right to register free of charge on the list opposing telephone canvassing (www.bloctel.gouv.fr).

7. Reimbursement of costs incurred to request the regulations

Request to be sent by simple letter to the address of the Organising Company appearing in article 8 of the Specific Conditions, specifying the name of the Competition concerned.

The request for reimbursement of the postage costs relating to the request for regulations will be made on the basis of a simple letter of less than 20 grams, stamped at the economy rate. It may be obtained on simple written request attached to the request for regulations, throughout the duration of the Championship, by sending a bank details statement (RIB) to the address of the Organising Company.

The reimbursement of the connection costs incurred for participation in this Championship will be reimbursed on simple written request to the address of the Organising Company and accompanied by a copy of the supporting invoice(s) as well as the following information: dates, times and durations of connection on the pages concerned. The reimbursement will be made on the basis of a local communication at reduced rate, for a duration that may not exceed ten (10) minutes. This reimbursement only concerns Participants who do not have an unlimited internet subscription. The request for reimbursement must be sent by simple letter to the address of the Organising Company accompanied by the bank details statement (RIB) of the holder of the Internet subscription and by a proof of the Participant's Internet subscription.

Any request for reimbursement that is in particular unfounded, incomplete, illegible, with inaccurate details or insufficiently stamped will not be accepted.

Any request for reimbursement received by electronic mail will not be taken into account.

Only one request for reimbursement per household will be taken into account.

No request for reimbursement will be honoured after a period of 15 (fifteen) calendar days from the closing date of the Championship.
